Re: Celebration of both General Chapters of the Poor Servants of Divine Providence Brothers and Sisters

Dearest Brothers, Sisters and Laity of the Calabrian Family!

The two General Councils are praying and entrusting all of you to God, every single member of your communities and families, that you may be in good health and grasp the signs of Providence, which knows how to do good even in these difficult times of pandemic.

It is known that the situation due the Coronavirus pandemic (Covid-19), one year after its worldwide diffusion, still creates public health problems, with the consequent partial or total restriction on transfers and international travels, in all the territorial realities where we are present. Therefore, the previous decision of the General Councils - to start the celebration of the respective General Chapters at the beginning of Lent 2021 – must be rethought again.

The General Councils of the Poor Servants of Divine Providence Brothers and Sisters, after hearing the advice of the Delegates and the in charge of Missions of both Congregations, have decided to postpone the celebration of the General Chapters in the summer (July/October) 2021, in Italy.

As soon as possible, we will set the start date and notify you.

We are invited, as we said several times, to live all this in climate of prayer and listening to the Holy Spirit; to contemplate and deepen the fruits of the great synodal movement that is involving the Opera: both religious and laity united in a big family, which, in dialogue, sharin and discernment, wishes to walk together and be ever more a prophecy of communion.
